

## How to Have a Home in Heaven

The Bible tells us that **we can know that we are going to Heaven:**

*“These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God.” - I John 5:13*

In order to know we are going to Heaven according to the Bible, we must **first realize that we have sinned against Almighty God** and are **not deserving of Heaven** on our own merit:

*“For all have sinned and come short of the glory of God.” - Romans 3:23*

Then we must understand that because of our sin, not only are we undeserving of a home in Heaven, but instead are **found guilty** by God and are awaiting a **sentence of eternal death** in the Lake of Fire:

*“But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death.” - Revelation 21:8*


